The **H2-B TEMPORARY VISA** is a government-sponsored **INS** / (Homeland Security) program. This program allows a foreign national worker to be sponsored by an employer with a temporary need for workers.

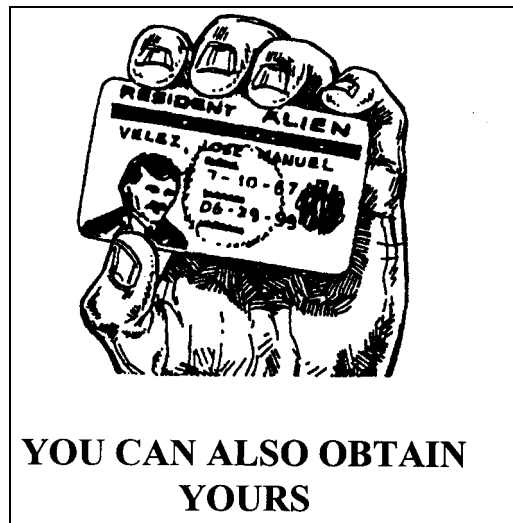
## **H2-B TEMPORARY VISA**

The Classification applies to an alien who is coming temporarily to the United States to perform non-agricultural work of a temporary or seasonal nature. Aliens qualify when unemployed persons capable of performing such services or available labor cannot be found in this country. The Department of Labor (DOL) must determine the temporary or permanent nature of the services or labor to be performed. This classification requires, if approved, a temporary labor certification and will be issued by the (DOL).

### **How is this done?**

The case is presented to the office of Employment in the State where the job is offered. A recruitment period is required and ads must be placed in a local newspaper with general circulation, the Internet and the State Job Bank. If there are no qualified workers for this position and the employer proves a seasonal need the case is usually certified by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Once the temporary labor certification is approved by the DOL the case is filed with INS (Homeland Security).

### **Qualifying Criteria for the H2-B**

The job and the employer's need must be one time, seasonal, peak load or intermittent.  
The job offer must be for less than one year; it must be proven there are no qualified and willing U.S. workers available for the position(s).  
The term is maximum 10 months and can be renewed 2 times for a total of 3 years.
